### **Parent Responsibilities:**

1. I understand that my child is eager for the camp experience, and not being “sent away” for my convenience.
2. My child’s cooperative at home and is a ‘good citizen’ at school.
3. I will be responsible to get my child a physical examination before camp.
4. I am responsible for the transportation to and from Camp Tecumseh, and the camper’s trading post account.  
The completed health and confidential forms must be returned to camp within 30 days prior to the camp dates.

**Parent commitment:** If a campership is granted for my child, I commit to fulfill the “Parental Responsibilities” outlined above and ensure that they will arrive at camp at the correct date and time as well as pick them up promptly at the end of the session. I also agree to coach my child about behavior that is acceptable at camp, as outlined in the “Behavior Contract”.

### **Camper Behavior Contract**

5. I will not use obscene or profane language, tobacco, alcohol, or any nonprescription drug.

7. I will not have any visible tattoos that the Camp Director deems inappropriate for a Christian youth camp.
