For this badge, girls will learn how to build a fire and tie several important and helpful knots. They will also learn about what to do in an outdoor emergency and what to pack in a first aid kit in order to treat and prevent injuries and illnesses.

In order to take part in the badgework, troops must schedule either a 2 Night/4 Meal or 2 Night/5 Meal stay at camp. Badgework will be scheduled for different times throughout the weekend, with plenty of time left to participate in other camp activities. Badgework is only available during March.
