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The Official Camp Tecumseh "What to Bring" List

Clothing

Dress at camp is casual; we suggest the following for each guest depending upon the time of year:

- 1 pair of pajamas
- 2 pairs of shoes (1 pair of tennis shoes, 1 pair of boots)
- Daily change of socks and underwear, plus 2 extra of each
- Heavy & lightweight shirt – one for each day
- 2 sweaters/sweatshirts
- Daily change of pants/jeans and/or shorts, plus 1 extra pair
- Jacket or coat
- Rain wear – poncho or rain coat

Bedding:

- Sleeping bag OR 2-3 blankets & sheets
- Pillow

Toiletries/Personal Care Items:

- Shampoo
- Comb/Hair brush
- Bar of soap
- Deodorant
- Hand soap
- Chapstick
- Hand towel and/or wash cloth
- Towel
- Toothbrush & toothpaste

General Items:

- Alarm clock
- Flashlight
- Wrist watch
- Sunscreen
- Medications

Optional Items:

- Camera & extra film, batteries
- Binoculars
- Fishing pole & tackle
- Board games, playing cards
- Sunglasses
- Bible
- Water bottle or travel coffee mug
- Portable "campfire" - Camp does not allow ground fires!

What NOT to bring:

- ALCOHOL or other controlled substances
- Knives
- Axes and/or saws
- Aerosol cans
- Bicycles, skateboards, in-line skates, razor scooters, snow sleds
- Firearms, archery equipment, etc.
- Fireworks
- Glass bottles

Camp Tecumseh YMCA Rules

- ***You know what tastes great after a wonderful day at camp? Water, pop, juice, milk coffee and tea--not alcohol.*** If alcohol is found, the entire group may not be allowed to return to Camp Tecumseh.
- ***Campfires are great; campfires on the ground, not so much.*** If you wish to have a fire in front of your cabin you must bring an above-ground portable firepit. Camp Tecumseh does not provide wood for personal fires. Due to the Emerald Ash Borer, we ask that guests not transport firewood to Camp Tecumseh. Please contact your group leader about ordering firewood.
- ***We encourage you to walk while at Camp Tecumseh.*** Please do not bring scooters, Wheely Shoes, Skateboards, Unicycles, Bicycles, Tricycles or any similar item.
- ***They say that fences make the best neighbors. We don't have fences at camp, so it's up to you.*** Please be respectful to your neighbors, both at camp and off camp property. Be mindful of loud music and talking, particularly at night.
- ***We're concerned about both safety and gas mileage, so please drive slowly.*** Camp Tecumseh has a posted speed limit of 10 MPH.
- ***It's important to leave someone behind to watch over your house, we recommend your dog.*** Dogs and other pets are not permitted at Camp Tecumseh.

Driving Directions

From Chicago Area:

Take I-65 South to Exit 188 (Brookston/Fowler).

Turn Left off ramp, heading East on IN-18

After ~6 Miles, Turn Right to stay on IN-18

Take the third Left (at the stoplight) to stay on IN-18.

After 5 Miles, Turn Left on Springboro Rd at blinking light.

Follow Springboro Rd for 1 Mile

Turn Right on Tecumseh Bend Rd

Take Tecumseh Bend Rd to the third entrance on the right—Lake Village

Check-in is at the Lake Village Trading Post

From Indianapolis Area:

Take I-65 North to Exit 178 (Brookston/West Lafayette)

Turn Right off ramp, heading North on IN-43.

After ~7 Miles, Turn Right on IN-18 (at the stoplight in Brookston)

After 5 Miles, Turn Left on Springboro Rd at blinking light.

Follow Springboro Rd for 1 Mile

Turn Right on Tecumseh Bend Rd

Take Tecumseh Bend Rd to the third entrance on the right—Lake Village
