Just think of your great- great- grandmother hand piecing precious little bits of fabric and then gathering her friends to sit around her quilt frame. Don’t you wish those conversations were recorded, as the ladies put thousands of tiny stitches into those quilts. We would love for you to give a “nod to the past”. Come mix the old with the new...take the classic, traditional, heirloom, vintage patterns and add a little twist that will give them a whole new look. VINTAGE VIBE, TRADITIONAL QUILTS, FRESH FABRICS by Amber Johnson. We fell in love with this beautiful book. The author has created 14 original quilt projects that have modern designs with vintage undertones. She has included simple to complex patterns, and you will be inspired by the fabric choices and quilting designs. *Scrap Jars*, 25 ½” by 33 ½”, is an adorable mix of modern and vintage. It makes me think of the lovely old jars that are filled with antique buttons, spools of thread and sewing supplies that my mother passed on to me. Mix 30’s prints, feed sacks, and favorite fabrics from your stash to piece the jars and the sweet little border. Have you wanted to make a quilt out of two solid colors? *Vintage Vibe* might just be the ticket. This 66 ½” x 82 ½” aqua and white beauty, really caught our eye. It is simple and refreshing, and will definitely show off any heirloom quilting pattern you choose.

QUILT CAMP T-SHIRT, The January quilt camp t-shirt will be long sleeved in a heather grey color. The “Sew Vintage” design will be on the front with the Quilt Camp logo on the back. All shirts must be pre-ordered.

VINTAGE BASKETS, by Cotton Way. This Fat Eight friendly pattern is a great way to use your stash. The pieced baskets with appliqued cherries make this quilt fun to make and unique. The designer used a new fabric line called Vintage Picnic. This is a cheerful, happy quilt that would look so pretty hanging in your kitchen, on a dining room table, or spread out for a picnic. Measures 62” x 62”.

VINTAGE TULIPS, by Thimble Blossoms. OK ladies, this has to be one of the sweetest little patterns you ever did see. I fell in love with the three beautiful pieced tulips at first sight, and knew it had to go in our Holland home. ‘Tulip Time’ is historic here... thus Vintage... thus a definite in this quilt camp lineup. All you need is a charm pack for the blocks and backing and a FQ of white for the background. You will be a master gardener when this 11” x 16” mini quilt is done! Look out, you just might end up making a whole *bunch* of these tulips- they are just so cute!

APPLEJACK, by Cluck Cluck Sew. This beautiful Fat Quarter friendly quilt screams, “Vintage”! The fabric choice is perfect for the pattern, and we can just imagine it being used a long, long time ago, on a distant relative’s bed. For the 60” x 68” throw size you will use 10 assorted fat quarters, 1 ¾ yards of solid fabric and 2 1/4 yards of neutral.




VINTAGE, by Cluck Cluck Sew. This striking pattern would be beautiful in just about any fabric line you choose. You can gather 9, 16, or 25 fat quarters depending on the size you want to make it. We made it out of the Daysail fabric line by Bonnie and Camille for Moda, which has vintage flowers, polka dots, colorful stripes and sailboats of course. This gave it a fresh vintage feel. The cover quilt used 16 FQ’s (blocks) and measures 73” x 73”.

RISE AND SHINE, by Thimble Blossoms. This Vintage quilt measures 60” x 72”, and has 12” blocks. It can be made with a Layer Cake OR a Jelly Roll. The fabric on the cover quilt is “Miss Kate”. There is a *mini* option for this pretty pattern that measures 13.5” x 13.5” and has 4.5” blocks.

GLAMPING, by Mary Jane. Glamour, camping, and vintage are all rolled up into one terrific quilt pattern. You can dress it up with some coordinating ric-rac if you want and you’ll be set for a new glamping adventure. The quilt measures 64” x 80”. One layer cake will make the 16 patch blocks. FARM GIRL VINTAGE, by Lori Holt of Bee in My Bonnet. Oh my, this is a fabulous book and it will probably become one of your favorites as you start to mix and match all of the wonderful choices that are offered. There are bushels of unique 6" and 12" blocks, and a quilter's bumper crop of inspirational patterns. The spiral binding and photographs make this a book that you will want to sit down and enjoy, cover to cover. Just a thought, you might want to mix up a picnic quilt using the mama hen, an egg basket, woolly sheep, farm house, strawberries, pie cherries, apron strings, pumpkin and the fresh flowers. The possibilities are endless! A dash of love and you will definitely have a winner. We checked out this book at the September camp, and it was a county fair champion!
