Requirements to be met by campership campers and families:

1. The camper is eager for the camp experience and is not being “sent away” by parents.
2. He/She is cooperative with parent/guardian at home and is a cooperative, ‘good citizen’ at school.
3. The parent/guardian is willing to commit to filling out all paperwork required for day camp.
4. The parent/guardian is responsible for the transportation to and from Camp Tecumseh or the payment for bus transportation.

Camper Behavior Contract

**(Parent/Guardian please THOROUGHLY review with camper
and make sure they understand the policies listed below.)**

I understand that the success of my camp experience depends on my attitude and behavior. If, in the opinion of the Day Camp Director, I violate the terms of this agreement, I may be dismissed from the program and not allowed to return. There will be no remittance of fees.

I, therefore, agree to follow the terms of this contract:

1. I will be courteous and respectful to everyone in the camp.
2. I understand that if I abuse or neglect camp property, I will be responsible for the damage, either through personally correcting the situation or paying for it.
3. I understand that as a camper, I will be held to the behaviors expected of everyone at Camp Tecumseh. This will include the following:
 - I will not use bad or negative words.
 - I will not wear any clothing the Camp Director deems inappropriate for a Christian youth camp.
4. I understand that I am a camper and must follow all of the rules set by camp and respect the authority of the counselors, directors, and all camp staff.
5. I will have a positive attitude and show respect, patience, and courtesy toward others, including my fellow campers.
6. I will act in a caring, honest, respectful, and responsible manner.
