Quilters have always been intrigued by house blocks, so we have gathered a wonderful collection of them for you to consider making. You might be drawn to a simple cottage with a cute little door and window box, a stately, sophisticated home with great detail, your “dream home”, a log cabin style house, or a quilty neighborhood full of colorful prints. Being the architect, you get to select the pattern, design and details you love. Make your house quilt classic, traditional, modern, or wonky. Add a bundle of your fabrics that will feel ‘right at home’ in your next “favorite” quilt. As you know, quilts can truly fill a home with love! Happy house building.

We are especially excited to announce that our Chief Architect, Nancy J, will be with us all week. She is bringing bolts of fabric, fat quarters, buttons, patterns, pins and needles, because it is her job to expose others to those essential building materials and get them excited about our neighborhood-house quilt- block- party. We will send you a complete list of fabric requirements, quilting supplies, and personal items needed when we receive your registration. You will definitely need to bring a sewing machine. Camp will begin on Monday morning and we will finish with Show & Tell on Friday right before we eat lunch. If you would like to arrive Sunday afternoon, September 9<sup>th</sup>, as an early bird camper, please note that on the registration form.

We are going to have our 15<sup>th</sup> annual book club discussion and plan to talk about *The Ladies Room* by Carolyn Brown. Secrets told in the church ladies room are supposed to stay in the ladies room, but that doesn't mean that what Trudy overhears there during her great aunt Gertrude's funeral won't change the rest of her life. This is a wonderful story of friendship, bonding and how life's upsets can often be blessings in disguise. We want to share a couple quotes from the book to peak your interest and get you started: “I had two choices. I could be bitter or I could get on with life. ...mine had been made. I wasn't going to be bitter”. “When opportunity knocks, you don't leave it standing on the doorstep, you invite it in and feed it chocolate cake”. Check your public library for a copy of the book.

Pick out your favorites, begin to gather your fabrics, and then pack your bags for camp. ...NEWS FLASH... 1. **PRETTY PLAYTIME QUILTS**, 6 charming quilts to treasure by It's Sew Emma. The six projects (including a tooth fairy pillow and a sweet sampler) bubble over with charm, imagination and whimsy. The quilt that caught our eye, is called “*Knock, Knock, Who's There?*” A dozen houses, each surrounded by 2 ½” squares, make this adorable 66 ½” x 84 ½” quilt. It is cute as a button, fun to make, and the talk of the town. Want to stay in the guest room?

2. I LOVE HOUSE BLOCKS, 14 Quilts from an All-Time Favorite Block. Welcome Home, House Blocks! Check out these patterns. So many to choose from and they are all different. Top notch designers have come together to present 14 all- new designs that display the variety and versatility of House blocks. We have our favorites and I guarantee you will too. We made *The Street Where You Live*, 64 ½” x 72 ½”, (are you already humming the classic song from My Fair Lady?) and *Tiny Town*. We want to make *Block Party*, a community of happy homes and trees that alternate with a row of pin wheels. Next up is *Four Generations*, a true celebration of the women in your family who share a love of quilting. Cute clusters of four houses in each block, surrounded by an Irish chain.
3. HOME AGAIN, by Lella Boutique. What a sweet adorable pattern...and talk about an ‘eye catcher’! 18-20 houses nestled together. They are so inviting and quietly yell, “Welcome Home”! Love at first sight. We want to live there! 64 ½” x 68 ½”.
4. ROOM AND BOARD, by Thimble Blossoms. 80" x 80" This is a fun pattern that is sure to show off your favorite fabrics. The sweet, simple, traditional log cabin quilt blocks are fat eighth friendly, and come together quickly to create a striking design. Rooms for Rent!
5. CHALET, by Kate Spain. Warm wishes abound in this festive quilt, that measures 56” x 68”. Design this quilt for the winter holidays or any day of the year, depending on your fabric selections. It’s a beautiful day in the neighborhood... Won’t you be my neighbor?
6. GOOD NEIGHBORS by Villa Rosa Designs. Gather 10 FQ’s of your favorite fabrics to make this striking design. September is the perfect time for getting together with your neighbors for a block party, and this pattern is all about “the party”! Bright, colorful, happy, playful ...ready, set, sew!
7. HAPPY SHACKS, by Black Cat Creations. Welcome to this delightful neighborhood! Here is your opportunity to create houses and trees with a “no rules” method. The funky, bright, whimsical little houses are sure to make a lot of little ones happy. Hometowns. Everyone has them! This could be yours. 48 ½” x 50”.
8. PAINTED LADIES, by Eye Candy Quilts. Here is an eye catching, 60” x 72” quilt. Piecing of one simple block and a clever layout gives the illusion that you are taking a walk to see the riotously colorful Victorian houses set in the hills of San Francisco. Once the houses are designed you can add colorful trim, ric rac, buttons and other embellishments to make each and every house, *Home Sweet Home*. Another option is FIERCE LADIES, the same design but on a smaller scale. Could be your granddaughters doll houses! 18” x 24”.
9. MY KINDA TOWN, by Laura Heine for Fiberworks. 42” x 54” Chip and Joanna would love to get their hands on this fixer upper neighborhood that features 9 whimsical paper pieced blocks in a quaint small town setting. The pattern includes complete instructions for the quilt and full sized patterns. The individual house blocks vary in size.
10. Quilt Camp T-Shirt-Comfort Color, Chalky Mint in long or short sleeve.






