Tecumseh Quilt Camp will be hosting a *World Series* baseball quilt camp in February. We would love for you to be on our team, the CT SCRAPPERS. Whether you enjoy the Infield, Outfield, pitcher's mound, dug out, bleacher seats, or concession stand filled with hot dogs, peanuts, popcorn and cracker jacks, we want you to step up to the plate for America's favorite past time, with a twist! Homeruns, stolen bases, and pop flies makes baseball an exciting sport to watch, but when it's combined with pretty quilts, nostalgic moments, and good friends...this is a quilt camp gathering of champions you won't want to miss. Start hunting for one of your favorite mitts, bats, baseball shirts, or pennants to share with us at camp.

Nancy J's Fabrics from Wabash, Indiana will be our in-house quilt shop. Nancy always gets a standing ovation for her quality fabrics, patterns, books, and notions. We will send you a complete list of fabric requirements, quilting supplies, and personal items needed when we receive your registration. You will definitely need to bring a sewing machine! Camp will begin Friday morning and we will finish with Show & Tell on Sunday right before we eat lunch. If you would like to be an early bird camper and arrive Thursday, February 14th, please make a note on the registration form.

1. **Hot Stuff Oven Mitt** – Create a designer silicone oven mitt with your favorite fabrics! The mitt is approximately 13" high and 7 ½" wide. The silicone overlay, instructions and templates are included. It will withstand high heat up to 450 degrees.
2. **Drop Diamonds** – by Cozyquilt.com is a cozy strip club pattern designed for 2 ½" strips. It is easy and intricate. You will use strips to make the block and then by adding a little accent to the corner, a whole secondary design is made! There are directions to make this quilt in 5 different sizes. Batter up! Step up to the plate, check out the diamond, get ready to swing...“Don't let the fear of striking out hold you back”. (Babe Ruth). This will be a home run!!
3. **triple play!** – Pink Parakeet Designs has a new pattern hot off the press and just in time for February camps spring training. The new pitcher is warming up, runners on first and second, it's the bottom of the 5th. A big play is about to happen! You will have an extra base hit with this quick large block quilt. Quilt blocks that have NO seams to match and simple strip-piecing make this pattern deceptively easy. The twin quilt measures 66" x 82" and the 20 blocks are each 16 ½".
4. **diamond run!**– A wild pitch and the runner on 3rd steals home and the CT SCRAPPERS take the lead. Large half square triangles in bright colors make this a surprisingly quick quilt to put together. This is a great beginner project, or a fast project for experienced quilters. The twin quilt measures 60" x 85", with 70-8 ½" blocks.
5. **double play!** Here we are in the top of the 9th and bases are loaded. The fans are going wild! We made a double play and are feeling like champions!! Could be headed for the World Series with this awesome pattern design. You will be seeing it come together quick as a wink, using a fast, 4 at a time, flying geese technique. The twin size quilt measures 62" x 81" and the blocks are 6 ¼". YES..... It's another home run!!!
6. **pennant race!**– There is some chatter on the diamond, in the stands and all around the ball park. This pattern is in a league of its own. CT SCRAPPERS, “Heads Up”. This could be yours. These quick to make flags will have you off to the ball field in no time. Make simple half square triangles in the bright colors of your home team or offer up some red, white and blue for a patriotic effect. Twin quilt measures 63" x 81" and has 63 – 9" blocks.
7. **play ball!**– (Featuring 7th Inning Stretch fabric) I had to do some homework for this one! Harry Carey started a popular tradition of singing Take Me Out to the Ball Game at a Chicago White Sox game. Other teams joined in and gradually started to add their own tunes. The Baltimore Orioles sing John Denver's, Thank God I'm a Country Boy. Mets like Piano Man, by Billy Joel. St Louis Cardinals like Here Comes the King, And Meet Me in St. Louis. The Texas Rangers and NY Yankees sing, Cotton Eyed Joe. Minnesota Twins sing Little Red Corvette by Prince. Houston Astros like Deep in the Heart of Texas. Los Angeles Angels sing, Build Me Up Buttercup. Detroit Tigers sing, Don't Stop Believin'. Cheryl of Pink Parakeet Designs will probably have a Garth Brooks tune for us to stand up and sing, but until then.. here is her latest and greatest baseball quilt design. The 64" x 82" quilt uses a baseball panel, and the blocks are 16" Square.






