

CAMP TECUMSEH PACKING LIST

Make sure to clearly label all items with your child's FULL name.

Do NOT Bring: Electronic Devices, Jewelry, Fireworks, Guns/Knives, Ammunition, Skate Boards, Bicycles, In-line Skates, or Pets. Drugs, Tobacco or Alcohol products are ground for immediate dismissal from camp.

CLOTHING

- T-shirts
- Shorts
- Long Pants (must be worn if opting to do a Trail Ride)
- Sweatshirt
- Pajamas
- Bathing Suits (2 or 3 to alternate throughout the week)
- Socks
- Under garments
- Sandals (for lake/pool/shower)
- Tennis Shoes
- Old clothes and Shoes for a “Mud Hike” (Croc-type shoes with back strap are acceptable)
- “Theme Dinner” Outfit (only needed for dinner Friday night – themes for each week can be found [HERE](#))
- Rain Jacket (optional)

ADDITIONAL CLOTHING ITEMS FOR EQUESTRIAN/HORSEMANSHIP CAMPERS ONLY:

- Long Pants/Breeches (leggings and yoga pants are not allowed while riding)
- Hard soled, Closed-toe shoes (tennis shoes are only acceptable for campers riding Western style)
- Campers riding English style should bring boots with a ½ inch heel
- Helmet (optional – Camp will provide an ASTM/SEI certified helmet for every camper)

BEDDING AND PERSONAL HYGIENE

- Pillow and Pillow Case
- Twin Size Sheets
- Sleeping Bag (needed for cabin Sleep out)
- Beach Towel
- Bath Towel
- Shampoo/Conditioner
- Body Wash/Face Wash
- Toothbrush and Toothpaste
- Comb or Hair Brush
- Shower Shoes (optional)

MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

- Reusable Water bottle
- Fan (small clip-on for bed – outlets available near each bunk)
- Sunscreen
- Insect Repellent
- Flashlight
- Snacks in a plastic box container with lid (optional – all snacks must be nut free)
- Sunglasses (optional)
- Journal or Notebook (optional)
- Disposable Camera (optional)
